**WELCOME!** This weekend we are delighted to welcome the **Most Reverend Lee Piche**, Auxiliary Bishop of our Archdiocese. Bishop Piche will preside and preach at the 9:30 Mass and we will have the opportunity to greet him at the St. Bridget Tea following Mass. This celebration in honor of St. Bridget of Ireland, the patron of our parish community, is one more in a series of events celebrating our Centennial. Along with Bishop Piche, we also welcome alumni, former parishioners, and guests who are joining us for this occasion...including the great woman herself—Bridget of Kildare! Although the Feast of St. Bridget is not celebrated on the American Calendar of Feasts, it is quite a grand celebration in Ireland where Bridget is honored at part of the “Irish Trinity” along with St. Patrick and St. Columille and looked upon as a model for women. Among other things, people seize her feast day as the beginning of spring. They weave Bridget’s Cross of Reeds and place it over the doors to their homes, businesses, and barns as a sign of her blessing.
