**UPDATE ON FR. ANTHONY:** The old cliché that tells us “the wheels of justice move slowly” is grounded in reality! Although the attorneys representing Fr. Anthony and his confreres have had a couple of meetings and court appearances since our last update there has been no significant movement on their case. At the present time their attorneys are engaged in the discovery process. That is they are reviewing documents and exhibits given to them by the prosecutor. These consist almost exclusively of various letters, documents, and reports that were seized from the corporate headquarters of the TOR Province of the Immaculate Conception by the Pennsylvania Attorney General last summer. In addition to this the friars are also considering various pre-trial motions. In the meantime Fr. Anthony and his confreres strive to make the best of their circumstances, trying to keep busy and hopeful in the face of the unknown. Fr. Anthony said that he continues to receive cards and notes of support from parishioners and friends and that these always brighten his day and lift his spirits. It is encouraging for him to know that so many good people are remembering him and praying for him. Next month he will travel to New York to spend time with family and meet another great-nephew, born in May. As their case progresses we will try to keep you apprised of any developments that affect Fr. Anthony’s status. In the mean time please keep him and the Franciscan community in your prayers. Remember also the victims of abuse, the local church, and all who are in need of physical, emotional or spiritual healing.

### MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT: MUSIC MINISTRY

Did you know that we have THREE different ensembles that sing/play throughout the school year? The **ADULT CHOIR** sings at Sunday Mass 2-3 times a month. The **PRAISE ENSEMBLE**, who focuses more on praise/worship style, sings on Sundays once a month. The **SATURDAY SCHOLA** sings twice a month. (“Schola” is Latin for “school,” more specifically referring to a music school in relation to the church or monastery.) The Schola and Adult Choir rehearse together on Thursdays at St. Austin’s from 6:30-8pm, September-May. Praise Ensemble rehearses once a week. If the weekly commitment is too much for you, you can sing seasonally (around Christmas and Holy Week).

So, do you love to sing? Consider joining the Adult Choir, the Saturday Schola, Praise Ensemble, or Seasonal Choir this year!
