**WELCOME!**

As we have started a new month, there will be some new faces around St. Bridget's. For those of you who attended Mass last Sunday, you know that Reverend Paul Jarvis, a priest of the Archdiocese, has been appointed by Archbishop Hebda as our Parochial Vicar for the duration of Fr. Anthony's Leave of Absence. This appointment is effective June 1, 2016. Substantially, a Parochial Vicar is what we used to know more commonly as an Associate Pastor. This new language better speaks the role of Parochial Vicar as one who acts in the absence of the Pastor to care for the pastoral and spiritual needs of a parish community. Fr. Paul will be living in the rectory at St. Bridget's and will be available for weekend and weekday Masses, the celebration of the Sacraments, and other pastoral situations that require his attention. Fr. Paul is recovering from a serious heart episode that forced him to retire his position as Pastor at Christ the King Parish in Minneapolis.

In order to facilitate his recovery and on-going good health, Rev. John Mitchell will continue in his role as Parochial Administrator and Deacon Rich Heineman has been appointed as Parish Life Administrator. In that capacity, Deacon Rich will tend to the day to day business life of the parish. We are grateful for Archbishop Hebda's concern for our parish community during this difficult time and pledge our support to Fr. Paul and Deacon Rich as they embrace their new roles.

On June 1st, we also welcomed back a dear and familiar face in the person of Rev. Jude Perera, TOR. You may recall that several years ago, Fr. Jude and Fr. Gregory, Franciscan Friars from the Province of Our Lady of Sri Lanka, lived in the Friary and attended graduate classes at St. John's University in Collegeville. Fr. Jude will be here for six weeks while he travels throughout the Archdiocese to make appeals on behalf of his Province and the good works they do. While he is in the area, he will be living in the rectory at St. Bridget's. Fr. Jude will have weekend responsibilities, but will be free during the weekdays. If you would like to help host Fr. Jude by inviting him for a meal or helping to transport him while he is with us, as he does not have a car, call the Parish Office during regular office hours.

**A JOB VERY WELL DONE** I want to take a moment to acknowledge one of our guitarists, Shaun Koelsch. Shaun has been playing once a weekend at St. Bridget's for 14 years. He received his bachelor's degree from St. Thomas in 2002 and his Master's degree in Guitar Performance from the University of Minnesota a few years later.
