## JUST WHAT THE DOCTOR ORDERED....

Three years ago, I went in for emergency surgery on an aortic dissection. That's when one's aorta expands, resulting in weakened tissue that could burst and bleed out. Statistically, only 10% survive such a situation, and often in a permanent vegetative state. I was blessed with a gazillion prayers and the best surgeon in the area. I was under the scalpel for 8 hours, and it was touch and go there for a couple of weeks after receiving Last Rites. After a slow two-month recovery, I returned to St. Joseph's Church in Rosemount as pastor. Against the advice of my doctors.

After two more years as St. Joe's pastor, I requested reassignment to a much smaller parish -- thinking a smaller parish would have less stress. You see, I have continuing damage in my aorta, and my doctors don't want me to have a lot of mental or physical stress. For example, I'm not supposed to lift much more than 10 lbs. I have to admit that transitioning as the pastor of a smaller parish -- Christ the King Church in Minneapolis -- was also against my doctors' advice.

They were right, and I was wrong. Again. Pastoring a small parish is as stressful as pastoring a big parish -- maybe even more so. Last March, after a visit to Urgent Care, my doctors finally ordered me to seek a priestly assignment in the diocese other as pastor. I also went on medical leave.

A couple of weeks back, Deacon Rip Riordan called me and said he had "the perfect assignment" for me — one where I won't be St. Bridget's administrative pastor ... but will serve as the long-term, resident, full-time "go to" sacramental priest for St. Bridget's during Fr. Anthony's leave. I'm happy to join an amazing staff team comprised of faith formation director, worship director, pastoral care minister, trustees, administrative assistant, parish nurse, maintenance staffers, deacon, sacramental minister and others ... all serving God's people worshiping and fellowshiping at St. Bridget's two campuses.

Deacon Rich Heineman and I will provide for the sacramental needs of our parish. In fact, Deacon Rich will effectively be acting as pastor as well as my boss during Fr. Anthony's absence. His position is that of Parish Life Administrator. I really look forward to being the go-fer clergyman, if you will, since I truly enjoy serving others. I get to focus entirely on liturgical, sacramental, and pastoral service. My doctors are happy, because they know service to others doesn't tire me out. Everyone I have met at St. Bridget's has been extraordinarily hospitable to me. I understand that folks who grew up in St. Austin's and St. Bridget's churches still come back to their spiritual home, even though more than a few live many cities away.

Frankly, it feels like I have won the lottery. God is indeed good.
