Archbishop Hebda has appointed Father John Mitchell as our temporary parochial administrator while Father Anthony is on leave. Father Mitchell is the pastor of the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Columbia Heights and has been there since January of 2012. He was ordained for the Archdiocese in 1996 and has also served at Saint John Neumann in Eagan, Saint John the Baptist in Jordan and Saint Pius X in White Bear Lake.

As parochial administrator, Father Mitchell assumes all responsibilities of parish governance that would normally fall to the pastor and will make sure our sacramental needs are met while Father Anthony is away from us. That includes making sure priests are here and available.

Please take the time to welcome Father Mitchell if you see him around Saint Bridget's and Saint Austin's campuses and offer your support, encouragement and appreciation.

Also, please note that parish staff had no prior knowledge of Pennsylvania's investigation into the Franciscan Friars (Third Order Regular) and Father Anthony as provincial of the Immaculate Conception Province. The case does not involve the parish in any way. Please be assured the staff will continue to be present to serve you.
