**MEET OUR NEW PARISH OFFICE MANAGER** On Wednesday, November 9, you'll see a new face sitting behind the desk in the Parish Office. **Manuela Georg** will be starting her new job as Parish Office Manager. For the past six months or so, we have relied on the generosity of many volunteers who answered your calls, let you into the office, and tried to keep things running as smoothly as possible while Jean has been away. We also appreciated the efforts of the Pastoral Staff to assist them and pick up the slack. However, we felt it necessary to hire a full time manager whose task it will be to oversee the management of the Parish Office, allowing the Pastoral Staff to do their jobs and ensure that the office runs as efficiently as possible and nothing or no one slips through the cracks.

At this time, Jean will continue to work in the office two days each week and will assist Manuela with clerical support and help her acclimate to her new surroundings. Manuela, who prefers to be called Ela (AY-la), comes to us with 20 years of experience in finance, church, and non-profit organizations. She has excellent communication skills and is proficient in the kinds of computer skills we need to make optimum use of the computer program that manages our parish census and other records. We welcome Ela and hope that this will be the beginning of a long and happy relationship with our parish community. At the same time, we wish to extend a word of tremendous thanks to those volunteers who gave so generously of themselves during these months: **Kathleen Ross, Alice Wortman, Julie Olmstead**, among others. We also thank **Jean Eidem** for all her years of service as the Parish Office Administrator and continue to pray that she will know better health and strength in the months ahead.

**UPDATE ON FATHER ANTHONY, TOR** Unfortunately, there is not much progress to report where Fr. Anthony and his confreres and community are concerned. The next meeting of their attorneys with the court in Pennsylvania will take place at the end of November. At that time, the attorneys will present any pertinent pre-trial motions and the Commonwealth may set a trial date. A hopeful bit of news is that the Attorney General who will be elected on November 8th may be a more reasonable person than their predecessor who will be willing to review the charges, which the friars' attorneys believe have neither factual nor legal basis. However, since this person will not take office until January 1st, nothing is likely to happen before the beginning of the New Year. In the meantime, Fr. Anthony continues to do the best he can, trying to remain patient and hopeful in the face of the unknown. Even after seven months, he is touched by the parishioners and friends who continue to support him with cards and notes of encouragement. These will be especially welcomed as the holiday season approaches. We all know too well how he labored to make the celebrations of Thanksgiving, Advent, and Christmas special for all of us. Please continue to keep Fr. Anthony, his confreres, and Franciscan Community in your prayers. We also continue to pray for all victims of sexual abuse and continued healing in the Archdiocese and wider Church.
