The ecumenical faith leaders of COME TOGETHER -- a coalition of churches and faith-based organizations committed to praying together for the end of violence in our community -- invite all to a service of music, prayer, contemplation and discussion. The coalition emerged following Philando Castile's funeral in the St. Paul Cathedral.

The prayer service will focus on the violence that burdens and divides our community, and its aftermath. Immediately after the service, there will be a Prayer Walk around the Capitol Hill neighborhood, stopping at locations of recent murders, and concluding on the Capitol steps.
