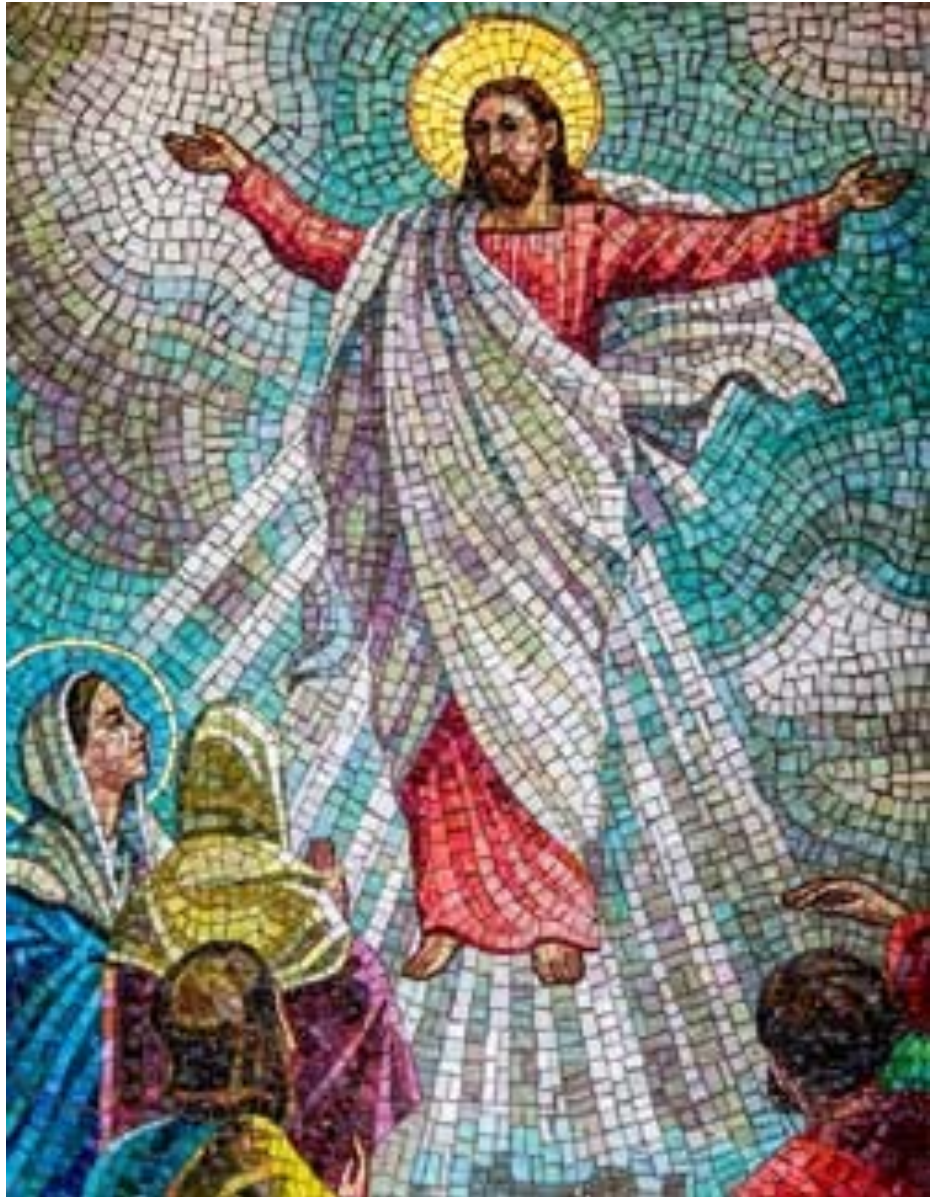

Living the Paschal Mystery

So many Christians long to have witnessed Christ. Why does he not appear anymore? Where is he now? These are questions the ascension is meant to answer. Jesus was ascended to his glory with the Father. The time of his appearance has been completed. And, now as we will learn in Acts, the gift of the Spirit has been given to us. Moreover, as we learn in the last chapter of Luke, we now come to know Jesus in the breaking of the bread. The ascension, then is not so much about a physically present Jesus floating up and up into the clouds as it is a theologically sophisticated concept proclaiming his eternal presence with the Father in glory. When we take this image too literally, we miss the theological truth it attempts to convey. As we live the paschal mystery we are reminded that rising with Christ is rising to new life. Rising with Christ is rising in glory with the Father. This is much more profound and sophisticated than flying through the sky without wings.
